Glass plate negative. View of a homestead with three barns in a "U" shape in the edge of a road. The barns are also at the bottom of a steep hill. The center barn and the one on the left appear to be of the same vintage, with unpainted, hewn planks set horizontally. The third barn appears to be a newer structure and may be painted. A fence, made of wood and wire, borders the dirt roadway that passes by the farmstead. Two cows and several chickens are in the fenced in area by the barns. A man stands in the barnyard with the animals. Another man and a child stand in the open doorway to the center barn. Chickens forage behind the barns.
