Photographic Print. Image is a detail from the Wharton Valley Grange No 991 located in Edmeston, Otsego County, NY. The image shows what is typically a finial on the end of a stave. This emblem may symbolize a sickle, a tool used in the gathering of a good crop and to Grange members the ability to "dispense charity to the needy" with the abundance.
